Attached to this memo, please find Draft Recommendations for Commission Consideration: A Delta Master Recreation Strategy - Phase I Aquatic Resources Focus. This work is the first part of a planned two part recreation strategy for the Sacramento – San Joaquin Delta. The attached document is the result of a cumulative effort between, the Recreation Citizens Advisory Committee (RCAC), DPC staff, The Dangermond Group, LSA Associates, Inc and other contributors.

The draft Recreation Strategy has been reviewed in pieces by the RCAC. Additionally, the Strategy was presented for review to the Delta Protection Commission on May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2005.

Steps to completing the attached document have included detailed reviews of existing Delta background materials, collecting input from stakeholders, preparing a draft aquatic physical plan and drafting implementation strategies that address O&M and funding sources.
